I offer my sincere thanks to you for your gift to the 2005 YMCA Partners Campaign. You and others who donate at the Chairman's Round Table level, are a huge reason why this year will be another landmark year for the YMCA on two important "scorecards".

First, I am pleased to report the YMCA has recorded pledges of \$3,342,455 in gifts towards this critical scholarship initiative, an increase of 3% over '04. Our Partners Campaign allows us to continue to say that, "no one is denied participation because of an inability to pay." With gifts from more than 15,000 donors, it is gratifying to acknowledge the broad base of support for our important work. I am encouraged that 38% of our donors (up from 24% in '04) are active YMCA members.

Second, we continue to do great work for thousands of kids and families. Although the need remains high, we are proud that people continue to look to the YMCA to provide support.

- We granted almost 18,000 scholarships totaling more than \$735,000 for day camp and child care so kids of working parents can have access to safe, fun care during the school year and this summer.
- In about six weeks we will award college scholarships totaling \$57,000 to 23 graduating seniors who will attend colleges across the country as a result of the legacy established in the Dallas YMCA Foundation.
- We already provided \$1.7 million in program and membership scholarships in the first six months of this year and expect to double that before we finish in December.
- We have provided more than 300 kids the opportunity to swim through scholarship requests from our community, including kids who were helped thanks to a special inner-city swim scholarship initiative. In addition, nearly 6,000 children heard the mantra, "Ready, Set, Save" in one of our water safety presentations through the "Know Before You Go" water safety awareness campaign.

Your support is vital to our efforts to build strong kids, strong families and strong communities. Thanks for all you do.
